Springfield to conduct walking audit and joint planning meeting

April 17, 2024–The City of Springfield will conduct its first-ever walking audit on Monday, April 22nd from 1 p.m. until 4:30 p.m. along 20th Street and the adjacent neighborhoods.

A walk audit is a tool used to help officials assess the existing conditions of a certain area and explore the possible improvements for enhanced mobility, increased connectivity, and future redevelopment.

The feedback and data collected from these community engagement efforts will be used to update the comprehensive plan for the city as well as develop a corridor plan for 20th Street.
